
The 'Participatory Turn' in Museums

From 'above' – a shift in cultural policy, a need to support local communities, regeneration, and generate own income

From 'below' – greater competition for more experience orientated visits

From 'within' – a desire to be part of local communities, to share knowledge, 'new museology', 'post-critical museology'.






Access Token

Interactive Token


