
Use Case 1 Fundraising with NFT in the Metamuseum: first experiences with a pilot project

### Project "Zukunft Kunstmuseum Bern"

### Reasons for the renovation

The expansion from 1984 is in urgent need of renovation. Otherwise it might have to be closed. Efficient and resource-friendly operation mean that the renovated building complex and new replacement building will offer more space for culture while still keeping operating costs stable. Unless its infrastructure is improved, the Kunstmuseum Bern will no longer be competitive.

### Participation – with and for the people of Bern

The Kunstmuseum Bern is shaping its future in close dialogue with the people of Bern. The Museum issued an invitation to participate in an open dialogue on the topic. It also talked to the people of Bern and visitors at public panel events, workshops, in surveys conducted during the "A Night at the Museum" event, and online to establish which needs the museum building of the future needs to meet. At the same time, some 50 workshops were conducted with the associated foundations, support associations, political representatives, businesses, the neighbouring police force as well as special-interest associations to provide information about the goals and opportunities of the Kunstmuseum of the future.

### What the new museum offers

Brightly lit exhibition rooms, a redesigned entrance and foyer zone, a modern events room, an opening toward Hodlerstrasse and the hillside on the Aare as well as digital and analogue art education: the museum of the future will facilitate new culture and art experiences for a broader, more diverse public. The focus will be on meeting visitors' needs.

### Sustainable and environmentally friendly

Renovation, conversion, new building and operation all meet climate protection and energy efficiency criteria. The new Kunstmuseum is a "sustainable Museum" and embraces sustainability in another sense (economic, ecological, social): by optimising its costs over the course of the building's lifecycle and making a positive contribution to the region's economy.

### Financed through a collaborative effort

The renovation project is a joint effort. It was developed in collaboration with partners and is now intended to be financed jointly by the public sector, private sponsors, and businesses. Everyone will benefit from a renovated Kunstmuseum with greater flair. In a first, innovative step, the fundraising project <u>Kunstmuseum Bern INFINITE</u> was launched in May 2023.




## EXPERIENCE & EXPLORE ARTWORKS IN VIRTUAL SPACE

- in future, additional works from our collection are to be digitally interpreted and presented




Johannes Itten (11.11.1888 – 25.03.1967) Horizontal-Vertical, 1915 Oil on canvas 73.7 x 55 cm

Johannes Itten's painting, constructed from abstract bars, was particularly well suited to being appropriated by Sasha Stiles, since it follows apparently logical compositional rules that were easily translatable into algorithms. Also the twelvetone music of which Itten was such a fan is systematically readable.

### Sasha Stiles


is an American poet and artist.

She is a pioneer in generative literature and blockchain poetry and has exhibited and given lectures in numerous countries.

She is the co-founder of verseverse, which is a platform for text-based, crypto-native art and has a mission of building the future of literature on the blockchain.

In 2022, she became the first writer to bring Al-powered literature to a major auction house when her poem, "COMPLETION: When it's just you," sold at Christie's. She recently collaborated in projects with artblocks, artcrush and playrecordmint among many others.





#### **A EYE**

The 12-piece series called "A EYE," explores Itten's theory of color and its significance for human emotions. Stiles also incorporates algorithmically generated verses, composed by a GPT-3 text generator and based on Itten's book "The Art of Color."


The color combinations from Itten's painting "Horizontal-Vertical" serve as a reference for the color scheme in Stiles' works, which are composed of continuously densifying text. The electronically compressed voice of the artist reciting the poem forms the third layer of the work.

The title "A EYE" is inspired by a neural network called A-EYE, which can recognize millions of colors through artificial intelligence. The 12-part structure of the series is based on Itten's 12-part color circle.







## **OUR POTENTIAL**


- NFTs / cryptocurrencies have partly a rather negative connotation
- For museums its not easy to reach the NFT-community in social media: twitter: 47 followers (organic); instagram: 144 followers (incl. paid post measures)
- the NFT-Market is down at the moment;
   selling the MVP only succeeded by lowering the price
- Business model in the presented form has not proven itself: It has become clear that patrons are still needed to operate the project as planned and to generate corresponding income for the "Zukunft Kunstmuseum Bern" project.
- Staffing and resources:
   To establish such a project the resources and staffing have to be planned for a longer period
